Half Day: \$17.00

Full Day: \$32.00

10 Day Half Day Pass: \$150.00

Monthly Pass: \$550 (To be purchased at the beginning of each month for that month. Unused days are not refundable or credited).

Morning Drop off time: 8:00am - 9:30am

Half Day: 8:00am - 1:00pm

Full Day: 8:00am - 6:00pm

Afternoon Pick up time: 4:30pm - 6:00pm

\*\*Please note, there is a 15 minute grace period. If you are more than 15 minutes late, you will be charged \$5 per 15 minutes.

### BOARDING PRICING:

\$40 each day

### INCLUDES:

2 walks each day. Daycare all day (Monday - Sunday 8:00am - 6:00pm). Snacks & Interactive play time each day.

### PICK UP:

Monday - Saturday by 10:00am. Sunday by 12:00pm or you will be charged for 1/2 day of doggie daycare (\$17.00).



**CANCELLATION POLICY:**

Carter's PET DEPOT requires 72 hours notice prior to the start of the reservation in order to cancel/change a NON-HOLIDAY boarding reservation without charge. During peak months & holidays, we require that a credit card be placed on file to hold a reservation. For policies regarding cancellations or reservation changes during these times, please contact the front desk. No-Shows and/or repeated cancellations will require a non-refundable deposit in order to book future reservations.

**MEDICATION:**

All prescribed medications must be in their original containers with doctor instructions labeled on the outside. Vitamins & over the counter meds can be in a temporary storage container provided that the pet's name, name of the medication & dosing instructions are labeled on the outside.

**FOOD POLICY:**

Please provide your own food for your pet or extra charges will be incurred.

Carter's PET DEPOT strives to provide a safe, stress-free facility for owners & their pets. However, some pets react differently to new environments & separation from their owners & there is even some risk that pets in the same family may play roughly & injure one another during boarding & play activities. In non-emergency situations (e.g. continued diarrhea, loss of appetite, etc.) We will contact the owner or the owner's designee to discuss the recommended protocol. For emergencies in which urgent care or evaluation appears needed, we will transport the pet to the appropriate animal clinic immediately & then contact the owner. Any costs arising from medical care that are paid by Carter's PET DEPOT will be billed to the owner.
